Relating to a policy on vaccine-preventable diseases for licensed child-care facilities.

SB 111 Lucio SP: Lucio III

Relating to the designation of Texas Historical Use Buildings.

SB 148 Williams/ Nichols SP: Toth

Relating to certain legal advice or legal services rendered to certain public servants.

SB 201 Birdwell/ Nichols SP: Price/ et al.

Relating to the continuation and functions of the State Preservation Board.

SB 211 Nichols/ et al. SP: Dutton

Relating to the continuation and functions of the Texas Facilities Commission; authorizing fees.

SB 217 Patrick/ Nichols SP: Anchia

Relating to the continuation and functions of the state employee charitable campaign.

SB 260 Davis/ Van de Putte/ et al. SP: Stickland/ et al.

Relating to the absence of a student from school to visit with a parent or guardian who will be or has been deployed on military duty.

SB 355 West SP: Lewis

Relating to the powers and duties of the Title IV-D agency regarding the establishment, collection, and enforcement of child support and in connection with an application for a marriage license or protective order; authorizing a surcharge.

SB 377 Lucio/ et al. SP: González, Mary/ et al.

Relating to the determination of certain exemptions from the administration of state assessment instruments to public school students and to the consideration of the performance of certain students on state assessment instruments.

Relating to the provision of state death benefits to certain employees of the Department of Public Safety of the State of Texas.

SB 406 Nelson/ et al. SP: Kolkhorst/ et al.

Relating to the practice of advanced practice registered nurses and physician assistants and the delegation of prescriptive authority by physicians to and the supervision by physicians of certain advanced practice registered nurses and physician assistants.

SB 540 Carona SP: Smith

Relating to the regulation, registration, and certification of inspectors for elevators, escalators, and related equipment.

SB 583 Carona/ et al. SP: Cook

Relating to eligibility for support from the universal service fund.

SB 660 West SP: Anchia

Relating to assessment collection in certain public improvement districts.

SB 715 Lucio/ et al. SP: Farney

Relating to counselors employed by school districts, including the use of consistent terminology in the Education Code to refer to school counselors and a license requirement for licensed professional counselors employed by school districts.

Relating to authorized charges and terms for certain consumer loans.

### SB 1461 Carona SP: Harper-Brown

Relating to addition of certain municipalities to the territory of a regional transportation authority.

# SB 1541 Van de Putte SP: Allen

Relating to discipline of public school students by school bus drivers.

# SB 1792 Watson/ et al. SP: Phillips

Relating to remedies for nonpayment of tolls for the use of toll projects; authorizing a fee; creating an offense.

### SB 1868 Campbell SP: Isaac

Relating to the creation of the Needmore Ranch Municipal Utility District No. 1; granting a limited power of eminent domain; providing authority to issue bonds; providing authority to impose assessments, fees, or taxes.
