Designating Nacogdoches as the official Garden Capital of Texas.

**SB 48 (CS) (LC)**                      **Zaffirini**  
 Relating to the transfer of a student from the school district of the student's residence to another district.

**SB 164 (LC) Van de Putte**  
 Relating to the issuance to veterans of specially marked licenses to carry a concealed handgun and specially marked personal identification certificates.

**SB 260 (CS) (LC) Davis/ Van de Putte/ et al.**  
 Relating to the absence of a student from school to visit with a parent or guardian who will be or has been deployed on military duty.

 Relating to a notification requirement if a public school campus or open-enrollment charter school does not have a nurse assigned to the campus during all instructional hours.

 Relating to the establishment of the Expanded Learning Opportunities Council to study and make recommendations concerning expanded learning opportunities for public school students.

 Relating to the creation of the Waller County Municipal Utility District No. 18; providing authority to impose a tax and issue bonds; granting a limited power of eminent domain.

 Relating to notice and election order requirements for bond approval elections held by political subdivisions.

**SB 646 (CS) (LC)                      Deuell**  
 Relating to court-ordered outpatient mental health services.

 Relating to the imposition and collection of a penalty for fraudulently obtaining unemployment compensation benefits.
