

## **SENATE FLOOR ACTION**

**Tuesday  
April 23, 2013**

**The Senate suspended the necessary rules to consider and finally pass:**

**SJR 1 Williams**

Proposing a constitutional amendment providing for the creation and use of funds in the state treasury to provide financial assistance for certain projects related to economic development and water infrastructure and for the transfer to the funds of money from the economic stabilization fund.

**2 Floor Amendments**

**SJR 42 Huffman/ Nichols**

Proposing a constitutional amendment relating to the sanctions that may be assessed against a judge or justice following a formal proceeding instituted by the State Commission on Judicial Conduct.

**SB 16 (CS) Zaffirini/ Eltife/ Seliger/ et al.**

Relating to authorizing the issuance of revenue bonds to fund capital projects at public institutions of higher education.

**SB 209 Huffman/ Nichols**

Relating to the functions and operation of the State Commission on Judicial Conduct.

**SB 315 (CS) Uresti/ et al.**

Relating to electronic voter registration.

**SB 376 (CS) Lucio/ et al.**

Relating to breakfast for certain public school students.

**SB 418 (CS) (LC) Ellis**

Relating to a notification requirement if a public school campus or open-enrollment charter school does not have a nurse assigned to the campus during all instructional hours.

Relating to the regulation of volunteer fire departments, volunteer firefighters, and members of industrial emergency response teams.

**SB 984 (CS) (LC) Ellis**

Relating to the meeting of a governmental body held by videoconference call.

**SB 1031 (CS) (LC) Taylor**

Relating to the Harris-Galveston Subsidence District; providing authority to impose a fee.

**SB 1034 (CS) Carona**

Relating to the unauthorized use of an alcoholic beverage permit or license; providing a criminal penalty.

**SB 1044 (LC) Rodríguez**

Relating to access to criminal history record information by a public defender's office and the office of capital writs and to an exemption for those offices from fees imposed for processing inquiries for that information.

**SJR 55 (CS) Williams/ et al.**

Proposing a constitutional amendment appropriating money from the system benefit fund for the purpose of returning system benefit fund fees to retail electric customers.

**SB 1387 (CS) Carona**

Relating to water well drillers and pump installers; changing fees.

**SB 1655 (CS) Williams/ et al.**

Relating to authorizing the Public Utility Commission of Texas to direct the comptroller to return the unappropriated balance of the system benefit fund to retail electric customers.
