**IN RE: HB2028** by Turner, Chris (Relating to the eligibility requirements for plumbing licenses issued to applicants with military service.), **Committee Report 2nd House, Substituted**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Occupations Code relating to the eligibility requirements for plumbing licenses issued to applicants with military experience and the issuance of those licenses.

Based on information provided by Board of Plumbing Examiners, this analysis assumes that duties and responsibilities associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be accomplished by utilizing existing resources.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
