Senator Hegar introduced the Reverend Scott W. Fisher, Rebecca Gregory, and David Scott Matthew, nominees to the Texas Juvenile Justice Board, to the committee. Senator Hegar indicated that he did not see the need to have all 13 members of the Texas Juvenile Justice Board appear before the committee. Senator Hegar felt it was important to the have the chair of the board, and the two newest members appear.

The three nominees to the Texas Juvenile Justice Board made opening statements and answered questions from the members of the committee.

The nominees to the Texas Juvenile Justice Board were left pending before the committee.

Senator Hegar moved that committee vote to approve the nominations of the individuals to the following entities: Alamo Regional Mobility Authority, Office of Independent Ombudsman for the Texas Juvenile Justice Department, Texas Education Agency, Texas Facilities Commission, Texas Juvenile Justice Board, and Texas Municipal Retirement System.
