Senator Fraser laid out the proposed Natural Resources committee rules for the 83rd Legislature and Senator Estes moved adoption of the Natural Resources committee rules. There being no objection, it was so ordered.

The chair laid out SB 281 and recognized the author, Senator Estes, to explain the bill. Witnesses testifying and registering on the bill are shown on the attached list. The chair moved that the public testimony be closed; without objection, it was so ordered.

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Senator Estes moved that SB 281 be reported favorably to the Senate with the recommendation that it do pass and be printed. The motion carried with a record vote of 10 ayes, 0 nays, 0 present not voting, and 1 absent. Senator Estes moved that the bill be recommended for placement on the Local & Uncontested Calendar; without objection, it was so ordered.

The chair moved that the public testimony be closed; without objection, it was so ordered.
