Relating to the number of members of the Texas Historical Commission.

HB 432 Riddle
Relating to charitable contributions by state employees to assist domestic victims of human trafficking.

HB 535 Davis, Yvonne | et al.
Relating to the preference given by state agencies to goods offered by bidders in this state or manufactured, produced, or grown in this state or in the United States.

HB 550 Turner, Sylvester
Relating to financing programs for low-income electric customers and certain other electric customers.

HJR 43 Flynn
Proposing a constitutional amendment prohibiting a court of this state from enforcing, considering, or applying a religious or cultural law.
