## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to member contributions to the Employees Retirement System
- 3 of Texas.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 815.402(a), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (a) Except as provided by Section 813.201, each payroll
- 8 period, each department or agency of the state shall cause to be
- 9 deducted from each member's compensation a contribution of:
- 10 (1) 9.5 [6.6 percent of the compensation if the member
- 11 is not a member of the legislature, for service rendered after
- 12 August 31, 2013, and before September 1, 2014;
- [(2) 6.9 percent of the compensation if the member is
- 14 not a member of the legislature, for service rendered after August
- 15 31, 2014, and before September 1, 2015;
- [(3) 7.2] percent of the compensation if the member is
- 17 not a member of the legislature, for service rendered after August
- 18 31, 2015, and before September 1, 2017 [2016];
- 19 <u>(2)</u> [<del>(4) 7.5 percent of the compensation if the</del>
- 20 member is not a member of the legislature, for service rendered
- 21 after August 31, 2016;
- [(5)] for service by a member who is not a member of
- 23 the legislature rendered on or after September 1, 2017, the lesser
- 24 of:

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- 1 (A) 9.5 [7.5] percent of the member's annual
- 2 compensation; or
- 3 (B) a percentage of the member's annual
- 4 compensation equal to 9.5 [7.5] percent reduced by one-tenth of one
- 5 percent for each one-tenth of one percent that the state
- 6 contribution rate for the fiscal year to which the service relates
- 7 is less than the state contribution rate established for the 2017
- 8 [<del>2015</del>] fiscal year; or
- 9  $\underline{(3)}$  [ $\frac{(6)}{(6)}$ ] eight percent of the compensation if the
- 10 member is a member of the legislature.
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
