## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

## AN ACT

relating to member contributions to the Employees Retirement System of Texas.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
SECTION 1. Section 815.402(a), Government Code, is amended to read as follows:
(a) Except as provided by Section 813.201, each payroll period, each department or agency of the state shall cause to be deducted from each member's compensation a contribution of :
(1) 9.5 [6.6 pexcent of the compensation if the membex is not a member of the legislature, for service rendered aftex August 31, 2013, and before September 1, 2014;
$[(2) \quad 6.9$ pexcent of the compensation if the member is not a member of the legislature, for service rendered after August 31, 2014, and before september 1, 2015;
[(3) 7.2] percent of the compensation if the member is not a member of the legislature, for service rendered after August 31, 2015, and before September 1, 2017 [z016];
(2) $[(4)$ 7.5 percent of the compensation if the member is not a member of the legislature, for service rendered Zfter August 31, 2016;
[(5)] for service by a member who is not a member of the legislature rendered on or after September 1, 2017, the lesser of:
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(A) 9.5 [7.5] percent of the member's annual compensation; or
(B) a percentage of the member's annual compensation equal to 9.5 [7.5] percent reduced by one-tenth of one percent for each one-tenth of one percent that the state contribution rate for the fiscal year to which the service relates is less than the state contribution rate established for the 2017 [z015] fiscal year; or
(3) [(6)] eight percent of the compensation if the member is a member of the legislature. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
