## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to member contributions to the Employees Retirement System 3 of Texas. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 815.402(a), Government Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 Except as provided by Section 813.201, each payroll 7 (a) period, each department or agency of the state shall cause to be 8 deducted from each member's compensation a contribution of: 9 (1) 9.5 [6.6 percent of the compensation if the member 10 is not a member of the legislature, for service rendered after 11 12 August 31, 2013, and before September 1, 2014; 13 [(2) 6.9 percent of the compensation if the member 14 not a member of the legislature, for service rendered after August 31, 2014, and before September 1, 2015; 15 [(3) 7.2] percent of the compensation if the member is 16 not a member of the legislature, for service rendered after August 17 31, 2015, and before September 1, 2017 [2016]; 18 (2) [(4) 7.5 percent of the compensation if the 19 member is not a member of the legislature, for service rendered 20 21 after August 31, 2016; 22 [(5)] for service by a member who is not a member of 23 the legislature rendered on or after September 1, 2017, the lesser 24 of:

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1 (A) 9.5 [7.5] percent of the member's annual 2 compensation; or 3 (B) a percentage of the member's annual 4 compensation equal to 9.5 [7.5] percent reduced by one-tenth of one percent for each one-tenth of one percent that the state 5 contribution rate for the fiscal year to which the service relates 6 is less than the state contribution rate established for the 2017 7 [<del>2015</del>] fiscal year; or 8 9 (3) [<del>(6)</del>] eight percent of the compensation if the

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member is a member of the legislature. 10

11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.

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
