- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 51, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 51.9193 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 51.9193. REQUIRED POSTING OF MENTAL HEALTH RESOURCES.
- 9 (a) In this section, "local mental health authority" has the
- 10 meaning assigned by Section 531.002, Health and Safety Code.
- 11 (b) This section applies only to a general academic teaching
- 12 <u>institution</u>, medical and dental unit, public junior college, public
- 13 state college, or public technical institute as those terms are
- 14 defined by Section 61.003.
- 15 (c) Each institution to which this section applies shall
- 16 create a web page on the institution's Internet website dedicated
- 17 solely to information regarding the mental health resources
- 18 available to students at the institution. The web page must include
- 19 the address of the nearest local mental health authority.
- 20 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 21 of this Act, each public institution of higher education to which
- 22 Section 51.9193, Education Code, as added by this Act, applies
- 23 shall post on its Internet website the information required by that
- 24 section.
