7 (a) The director by rule shall establish minimum standards

for handgun proficiency and shall develop a course to teach handgun

proficiency and examinations to measure handgun proficiency. The

10 course to teach handgun proficiency is required for each person who

11 seeks to obtain or renew a license and must contain training

12 sessions divided into two parts. One part of the course must be

13 classroom instruction and the other part must be range instruction

14 and an actual demonstration by the applicant of the applicant's

15 ability to safely and proficiently use a handgun. An applicant must

16 be able to demonstrate, at a minimum, the degree of proficiency that

17 is required to effectively operate a handgun of .22 [.32] caliber or

18 above. The department shall distribute the standards, course

19 requirements, and examinations on request to any qualified handgun

20 instructor.

21 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only

22 to an application to obtain or renew a license to carry a concealed
