BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 1-23 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 262, Family Code, amended by adding Section 262.011 to read as follows: is

1-24 Sec. 262.011. SEALING OF COURT RECORDS FILED ELECTRONICALLY. For purposes of determining whether to seal documents in accordance with Rule 76a, Texas Rules of Civil Procedure, in a suit under this subtitle, the court shall consider documents filed through an electronic filing system in the same manner as any other document filed with the court. 1-25 1-26 1-27 1-28 1-29

1-30 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to a 1-31 suit affecting the parent-child relationship that is pending in a trial court on or filed on or after the effective date of this Act. 1-32

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 1-33 1-34 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 1-35 1-36 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-37 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
