| 9 | 1701.261. An officer shall complete the program not later than the |
| 10 | second anniversary of the date the officer is licensed under this |
| 11 | chapter or the date the officer applies for an intermediate |
| 12 | proficiency certificate, whichever date is earlier. The training |
| 13 | program required under this subsection may not be provided as ar |
| 14 | online course. |
| 15 | SECTION 2. Subchapter F, Chapter 1701, Occupations Code, is |
| 16 | amended by adding Section 1701.261 to read as follows: |
| 17 | Sec. 1701.261. ANIMAL ENCOUNTER TRAINING PROGRAM. (a) The |
| 18 | commission shall establish a statewide comprehensive education and |
| 19 | training program on animal encounters and animal behavior. The |
| 20 | training program must consist of at least eight hours of classroom |
| 21 | instruction and practical training and may include the use of live |
| 22 | animals in: |
| 23 | (1) handling animal-related calls or unplanned |
| 24 | encounters with animals, with an emphasis on canine-related |

- 1 incidents and the use of nonlethal methods and tools in handling an
- 2 encounter;
- 3 (2) identifying and understanding animal behavior;
- 4 (3) laws and ordinances related to animals;
- 5 (4) avoiding an animal attack; and
- 6 (5) using nonlethal methods to defend against an
- 7 <u>animal attack.</u>
- 8 (b) At least once every four years, the commission shall
- 9 review the content of the training program under this section and
- 10 update the program as necessary.
- 11 (c) Except as provided by Section 1701.352(b-1), an officer
- 12 who completes the training program established under this section
- 13 is not required to retake the program.
- 14 SECTION 3. Section 1701.352, Occupations Code, is amended
- 15 by adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:
- 16 (b-1) The commission shall require each officer to complete
- 17 the animal encounter training program established by the commission
- 18 under Section 1701.261 at least once every 48 months. The training
- 19 program required under this subsection may be provided as an online
- 20 continuing education course.
- 21 SECTION 4. Section 1701.402, Occupations Code, is amended
- 22 by adding Subsection (1) to read as follows:
- 23 (1) As a requirement for an intermediate proficiency
- 24 certificate, an officer must complete the animal encounter training
- 25 program established by the commission under Section 1701.261. The
- 26 training program required under this subsection may not be provided
- 27 as an online course.

- 1 SECTION 5. Not later than January 1, 2016, the Texas
- 2 Commission on Law Enforcement shall establish the animal encounter
- 3 training program as required by Section 1701.261, Occupations Code,
- 4 as added by this Act.
- 5 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
