1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to the designation of a portion of State Highway 207 in
 1-22 Armstrong County as the William Hamblen Memorial Highway.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,
 1-25 is amended by adding Section 225.106 to read as follows:

1-26 Sec. 225.106. WILLIAM HAMBLÉN MEMORIAL HIGHWAY. (a) The
 1-27 portion of State Highway 207 in Armstrong County between its
 1-28 intersection with Farm-to-Market Road 2272 and Farm-to-Market Road
 1-29 285 is designated as the William Hamblen Memorial Highway.

1-30 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

1-31 (1) design and construct markers indicating the
 1-32 designation as the William Hamblen Memorial Highway and any other
 1-33 appropriate information; and

1-34 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at
 1-35 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

1-36 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-37 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-38 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-39 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-40 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
