1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 1-24 SECTION 1. Section 96.707(k), Education Code, is amended to 1-25 read as follows:

1-26 (k) For each student enrolled in the academy, the academy is 1-27 entitled to allotments from the Foundation School Program under 1-28 Chapter 42 as if the academy were a school district without a tier 1-29 one local share for purposes of Section 42.253 [, except that the 1-30 academy has a local share applied that is equivalent to the local 1-31 fund assignment of the Beaumont Independent School District].

1-32 SECTION 2. Section 96.707(k), Education Code, as amended by 1-33 this Act, applies beginning with the 2015-2016 academic year.
