 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the provision of information relating to the
 1-20 modification of a child support order in certain suits affecting
 1-21 the parent-child relationship.

1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. Section 105.006, Family Code, is amended by
 1-24 adding Subsection (e-2) to read as follows:

1-25 (e-2) An order in a suit that orders child support must
 1-26 contain the following prominently displayed statement in boldfaced
 1-27 type, in capital letters, or underlined:

1-28 "THE COURT MAY MODIFY THIS ORDER THAT PROVIDES FOR THE
 1-29 SUPPORT OF A CHILD, IF:

1-30 (1) THE CIRCUMSTANCES OF THE CHILD OR A PERSON
 1-31 AFFECTED BY THE ORDER HAVE MATERIALLY AND SUBSTANTIALLY CHANGED; OR

1-32 (2) IT HAS BEEN THREE YEARS SINCE THE ORDER WAS
 1-33 RENDERED OR LAST MODIFIED AND THE MONTHLY AMOUNT OF THE CHILD
 1-34 SUPPORT AWARD UNDER THE ORDER DIFFERS BY EITHER 20 PERCENT OR \$100
 1-35 FROM THE AMOUNT THAT WOULD BE AWARDED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CHILD
 1-36 SUPPORT GUIDELINES."

1-37 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to a
 1-38 suit affecting the parent-child relationship pending in a trial
 1-39 court on or filed on or after the effective date of this Act.

1-40 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
