1-20 relating to the compatibility of state agency websites with certain
 1-21 devices and Internet browsers.

1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 2054, Government Code, is
 1-24 amended by adding Section 2054.134 to read as follows:

1-25 Sec. 2054.134. DEVICE AND INTERNET BROWSER COMPATIBILITY.

1-26 (a) In this section, "wireless communication device" means a
 1-27 device capable of using a commercial mobile service as defined by 47
 1-28 U.S.C. Section 332.

1-29 (b) The department shall identify the three most commonly
 1-30 used Internet browsers and post a list containing those browsers in
 1-31 a conspicuous location on the department's Internet website. The
 1-32 department shall biennially review and, if necessary, update the
 1-33 list required under this subsection.

1-34 (c) Each state agency that maintains a generally accessible
 1-35 Internet website or for which a generally accessible Internet
 1-36 website is maintained shall ensure that the website is compatible
 1-37 with:

- 1-38 (1) a wireless communication device; and
- 1-39 (2) the most recent version of each Internet browser
 1-40 listed by the department as required under Subsection (b).

1-41 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
