1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to the display of notice of federal and state tax rates for
 1-22 motor fuel sold at retail.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 17, Agriculture Code, is
 1-25 amended by adding Section 17.0515 to read as follows:

1-26 Sec. 17.0515. NOTICE OF MOTOR FUEL TAX RATES. (a) The
 1-27 department shall display or require to be displayed on each motor
 1-28 fuel pump from which motor fuel is sold at retail a notice of the
 1-29 current rates of the federal and state motor fuel taxes. The notice
 1-30 must:

1-31 (1) display the current rate of each tax, in cents per
 1-32 gallon, for each type of motor fuel;

1-33 (2) be displayed on each face of the motor fuel pump on
 1-34 which the price of the motor fuel sold from the pump is displayed;
 1-35 and

1-36 (3) be displayed in a clear, conspicuous, and
 1-37 prominent manner.

1-38 (b) The department may include the notice required under
 1-39 Subsection (a) with any other notice displayed or required by
 1-40 department rule to be displayed, including a "Fuel Feedback?"
 1-41 sticker.

1-42 SECTION 2. The Department of Agriculture is not required to
 1-43 display, or may not require to be displayed, a notice on a motor
 1-44 fuel pump under Section 17.0515, Agriculture Code, as added by this
 1-45 Act, until the later of the date:

1-46 (1) the department is at the pump's location for an
 1-47 inspection or other official business; or

1-48 (2) the department's inventory of "Fuel Feedback?"
 1-49 stickers on hand on the effective date of this Act is used and the
 1-50 department acquires new stickers.

1-51 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect January 1, 2016.
