A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to notice provided to a court regarding certain defendants placed on state jail felony community supervision. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 15(f), Article 42.12, Code of Criminal 5 Procedure, is amended by adding Subdivision (2-a) to read as 6 7 follows: (2-a) Not later than the 60th day after the date a 8 9 defendant is received into the custody of a state jail felony facility, the Texas Department of Criminal Justice shall notify the 10 sentencing court of the date on which the defendant will have served 11 12 75 days in the facility. The notice must be provided by e-mail or other electronic communication. 13 14 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act to Section 15(f), Article 42.12, Code of Criminal Procedure, applies only to a 15 defendant who receives a sentence of confinement in a state jail on 16 or after the effective date of this Act. A defendant who receives a 17 sentence of confinement in a state jail before the effective date of 18 this Act is governed by the law in effect at the time of sentencing, 19 20 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
