1-17 relating to designating September as Hydrocephalus Awareness
1-18 Month.

1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Section 662.106(a), Government Code, is amended
1-21 to read as follows:

1-22 (a) September [~~October~~] is Hydrocephalus Awareness Month
1-23 to:

1-24 (1) increase public awareness of hydrocephalus, a
1-25 serious neurological condition characterized by the abnormal
1-26 buildup of cerebrospinal fluids in the ventricles of the brain; and

1-27 (2) encourage the development of partnerships between
1-28 the federal government, health care professionals, and patient
1-29 advocacy groups to advance the public's understanding of the
1-30 condition, improve the diagnosis and treatment of the condition,
1-31 and support research for a cure.

1-32 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-33 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-34 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-35 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-36 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.

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
