A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1-17 relating to the regulation of certain motor vehicle auctions. 1-18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-19 SECTION 1. Section 1802.002(a), Occupations Code, is 1-20 amended to read as follows: 1-21

This chapter does not apply to: (a)

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1-22 1-23 a sale conducted by order of a United States court (1)under Title 11, United States Code;

(2) a sale conducted by an employee of the United 1-24 1-25 States, this state, or a political subdivision of this state in the 1-26 course and scope of employment;

1-27 a sale conducted by a charitable, religious, or (3) 1-28 civic organization, including an organization having a tax exempt status under Section 501(c), Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or 1-29 organized as a nonprofit entity, if the person organizing, arranging, or conducting the auction receives no compensation; 1-30 1-31

(4) a sale conducted by any person of the person's property if the person is not engaged in the business of selling 1-32 1-33 1-34 property at auction on a recurring basis;
