1-19 relating to the membership of the Electrical Safety and Licensing
 1-20 Advisory Board.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section [1305.051\(a\)](#), Occupations Code, is
 1-23 amended to read as follows:

1-24 (a) The advisory board consists of nine members appointed by
 1-25 the presiding officer of the commission with the approval of the
 1-26 commission as follows:

- 1-27 (1) three master electrician members;
- 1-28 (2) three journeyman electrician members; ~~and~~
- 1-29 (3) one master sign electrician member; and
- 1-30 (4) two [three] public members.

1-31 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act to Section
 1-32 [1305.051\(a\)](#), Occupations Code, regarding the qualifications for a
 1-33 member of the Electrical Safety and Licensing Advisory Board do not
 1-34 affect the entitlement of a member serving on the board immediately
 1-35 before the effective date of this Act to continue to serve and
 1-36 function as a member of the board for the remainder of the member's
 1-37 term. When board vacancies occur on or after the effective date of
 1-38 this Act, the presiding officer of the Texas Commission of
 1-39 Licensing and Regulation shall appoint new members to the board in a
 1-40 manner that reflects the changes in law made by this Act.

1-41 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
