1-19 relating to the definition of a state judge for purposes of state
 1-20 driver's license and personal identification laws.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 521.001(a)(8-a), Transportation Code,
 1-23 is amended to read as follows:

1-24 (8-a) "State judge" means:

1-25 (A) the judge of an appellate court, a district
 1-26 court, ~~or~~ a county court at law, or a statutory probate court of
 1-27 this state; or

1-28 (B) an associate judge appointed under Chapter
 1-29 201, Family Code, Chapter 54A, Government Code, or Chapter 574,
 1-30 Health and Safety Code.

1-31 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-32 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-33 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-34 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-35 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
