1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the compensation of property owners whose property is  
1-20 damaged as a result of a pursuit involving a federal law enforcement  
1-21 agency.

1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. Section [683.015\(f\)](#), Transportation Code, is  
1-24 amended to read as follows:

1-25 (f) A law enforcement agency or an attorney representing the  
1-26 state may use funds transferred under Subsection (d) to compensate  
1-27 property owners whose property was damaged as a result of a pursuit  
1-28 involving a law enforcement agency or a federal law enforcement  
1-29 agency, regardless of whether the agency would be liable under  
1-30 Chapter 101, Civil Practice and Remedies Code.

1-31 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only  
1-32 to property damage occurring on or after the effective date of this  
1-33 Act. Property damage occurring before the effective date of this  
1-34 Act is governed by the law in effect at the time the damage  
1-35 occurred, and the former law is continued in effect for that  
1-36 purpose.

1-37 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-38 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-39 provided by Section [39](#), Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-40 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-41 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.

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
