 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the designation of a portion of U.S. Highway 290 in Hays
 1-20 and Travis Counties as the Lieutenant Clay Crabb Memorial Highway.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,
 1-23 is amended by adding Section 225.102 to read as follows:

1-24 Sec. 225.102. LIEUTENANT CLAY CRABB MEMORIAL HIGHWAY. (a)
 1-25 The portion of U.S. Highway 290 between its intersection with
 1-26 Circle Drive in Travis County and its intersection with Hays
 1-27 Country Acres Road in Hays County is designated as the Lieutenant
 1-28 Clay Crabb Memorial Highway. The designation is in addition to any
 1-29 other designation.

1-30 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

1-31 (1) design and construct markers indicating the
 1-32 designation as the Lieutenant Clay Crabb Memorial Highway and any
 1-33 other appropriate information; and

1-34 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at
 1-35 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

1-36 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
