## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1-19 relating to financial assistance paid to the survivors of certain 1-20 law enforcement officers, firefighters, and other public employees killed in the line of duty. 1-21

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 1-23 SECTION 1. Section 615.022, Government Code, is amended to 1-24 read as follows:

1-25 Sec. 615.022. PAYMENT TO SURVIVORS. (a) If there is an 1-26 eligible surviving spouse, the state shall pay \$500,000 [\$250,000] to the eligible surviving spouse. 1-27

1-28 (b) If there is no eligible surviving spouse, the state 1-29 \$500**,**000  $[\frac{250,000}{2}]$  in equal shares to surviving shall pay 1-30 children.

1-31 (c) If there is no eligible surviving spouse or child, the state shall pay \$500,000 [\$250,000] in equal shares to surviving 1-32 1-33 parents.

Sections 615.023(a) and (b), Government Code, 1-34 SECTION 2. 1-35 are amended to read as follows:

(a) The state shall pay to the duly appointed or qualified guardian or other legal representative of an eligible surviving 1-36 1-37 1-38 minor child:

1-39 (1)\$400 [\$200] each month, if there is one surviving 1-40 child;

<u>\$600</u> [<del>\$300</del>] each month, if there are two surviving 1-41 (2) 1-42 children; or

1-43 \$800 [\$400] each month, if there are three or more (3)1-44 surviving children.

1-45 A child's entitlement to assistance payable under this (b) 1-46 section ends on the last day of the month that includes the child's 18th birthday. At that time, payments to any other surviving minor 1-47 children shall be adjusted, as necessary, to conform to the amounts 1-48 1-49 payable under Subsection (a).

1-50 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply in relation to a payment of assistance made to survivors of certain public servants on or after the effective date of this Act 1-51 1-52 1-53 regardless of the date the death of the public servant occurs. 1-54 This Act takes effect September 1, 2015. SECTION 4.
