1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the reimbursement of expenses incurred by court
1-20 reporters in judicial districts composed of more than one county.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 52.055(b), Government Code, is amended
1-23 to read as follows:

1-24 (b) Travel expenses reimbursed under this section may not
1-25 exceed the reasonable mileage rate set by the commissioners court
1-26 of the respective county of the judicial district for which the
1-27 expenses were incurred [25 cents per mile] for the use of private
1-28 conveyances, traveling the shortest practical route.

1-29 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to
1-30 expenses incurred by a court reporter on or after the effective date
1-31 of this Act. Expenses incurred by a court reporter before the
1-32 effective date of this Act are governed by the law in effect on the
1-33 date the expenses were incurred, and the former law is continued in
1-34 effect for that purpose.

1-35 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
