1-19 relating to the approval of certain alcoholic beverages by the
 1-20 Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 101.671(b), Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
 1-23 amended to read as follows:

1-24 (b) On registration of a certificate of label approval
 1-25 issued by the United States Alcohol and Tobacco Tax and Trade
 1-26 Bureau, the commission shall approve the product under this section
 1-27 and issue a letter to that effect to the permittee. The commission
 1-28 may not require additional approval for the product unless there is
 1-29 a change to the label or product that requires reissuance of the
 1-30 federal certificate of label approval. The commission shall accept
 1-31 the certificate of label approval as constituting full compliance
 1-32 only with any applicable standards adopted under Section 5.38
 1-33 regarding quality, purity, and identity of distilled spirits or
 1-34 wine.

1-35 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
