1-17 relating to the Texas Identification Number system.
 1-18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
 1-19 SECTION 1. Sections 403.039(a) and (b), Government Code,
 1-20 are amended to read as follows:
 1-21 (a) The comptroller shall assign a Texas Identification
 1-22 Number [~~based on the comptroller's taxpayer identification number~~
 1-23 ~~system,~~] to each person [~~other than a state employee,~~] who
 1-24 supplies property or services to the state for compensation or
 1-25 reimbursement.
 1-26 (b) The Texas Identification Number system shall be used by
 1-27 each state agency as the primary identification system for
 1-28 persons [~~other than state employees,~~] who supply property or
 1-29 services to the agency for compensation or reimbursement. The
 1-30 agency may assign secondary numbers if the secondary numbering
 1-31 system does not unnecessarily create duplication of data bases,
 1-32 efforts, or costs.
 1-33 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-34 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-35 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-36 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-37 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
