(2) allows an unmanned aircraft to make contact with a critical infrastructure facility, including any person or object on the premises of or within the facility; or

(3) allows an unmanned aircraft to come within distance of a critical infrastructure facility that is close enough to interfere with the operations of or cause a disturbance to the facility.

This section does not apply to conduct described by Subsection (b) that is committed by:

(1) the federal government, the state, governmental entity;

(2) a person under contract with or otherwise acting direction or on behalf of the federal government, the under the state, or a governmental entity;
