- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 52.047, Government Code, is amended by 6 adding Subsection (h) to read as follows:
- 7 (h) A court reporter may not be required to file an official
- 8 transcript of a trial before the 60th day after the date a notice of
- 9 appeal is filed. To the extent this subsection conflicts with the
- 10 Texas Rules of Appellate Procedure or other rules of procedure,
- 11 this subsection controls. Notwithstanding Sections 22.003,
- 12 22.004, and 22.108, the supreme court or the court of criminal
- 13 appeals may not amend or adopt a rule in conflict with this section.
- 14 This subsection does not apply to an official transcript required
- 15 for an accelerated appeal or an interlocutory appeal.
- 16 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to a
- 17 notice of appeal that is filed on or after the effective date of
- 18 this Act. A notice of appeal filed before the effective date of
- 19 this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the notice was
- 20 filed, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
