## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 1-23 SECTION 1. The Securities Act (Article 581-1 et seq., Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes) is amended by adding Section 44 to 1-24 read as follows:

1-25 <u>Sec</u>. 44. CROWDFUNDING. (a) The Board shall adopt rules to regulate and facilitate online intrastate crowdfunding applicable 1-26 1-27 to authorized small business development entities.
