1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the continuation of the Texas Council for Developmental  
1-20 Disabilities.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section [112.023](#), Human Resources Code, is  
1-23 amended to read as follows:

1-24 Sec. 112.023. SUNSET PROVISION. The Texas Council for  
1-25 Developmental Disabilities is subject to Chapter 325, Government  
1-26 Code (Texas Sunset Act). Unless continued in existence as provided  
1-27 by that chapter, the council is abolished and this chapter expires  
1-28 September 1, ~~2027~~ 2015.

1-29 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-30 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-31 provided by Section [39](#), Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-32 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-33 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
