BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 1-23 SECTION 1. Chapter 253, Local Government Code, is amended by adding Section 253.0125 to read as follows:

1-24 Sec. 253.0125. CONVEYANCE OF PROPERTY FOR ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PURPOSES. (a) This section applies only to an entity 1-25 and a municipality that have entered into an economic development 1-26 agreement authorized by Chapter 380. (b) Notwithstanding Section 1-27

1-28 272.001(a) or other law, 1-29 municipality may transfer to an entity real property or an interest 1-30 in real property for consideration described by this section.
