 1-17 AN ACT

1-18 relating to job performance on behalf of a fire fighter or police
 1-19 officer who is recovering from an off-duty injury.

1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-21 SECTION 1. Section 143.073(d), Local Government Code, is
 1-22 amended to read as follows:

1-23 (d) If a fire fighter or police officer is temporarily
 1-24 disabled by an injury or illness that is not related to the person's
 1-25 line of duty, the person may:

1-26 (1) use all sick leave, vacation time, and other
 1-27 accumulated time before the person is placed on temporary leave; or

1-28 (2) have another fire fighter or police officer
 1-29 volunteer to do the person's work while the person is temporarily
 1-30 disabled by the injury or illness.

1-31 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
