1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to participation of certain school districts in the  
 1-22 three-year high school diploma plan pilot program.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 28.0255(b), Education Code, is amended  
 1-25 to read as follows:

1-26 (b) This section applies only to a school district:

1-27 (1) with an enrollment of more than 150,000  
 1-28 students~~[+]~~ and

1-29 ~~[(2)]~~ located primarily in a county with ~~[that has]~~ a  
 1-30 population of 2.2 million or more ~~[and]~~ that is adjacent to a county  
 1-31 with a population of more than 600,000; or

1-32 (2) with an enrollment of more than 5,000 but less than  
 1-33 7,000 students and located primarily in a county that contains the  
 1-34 headwaters of the San Gabriel River.

1-35 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
 1-36 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
 1-37 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
 1-38 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
 1-39 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
