A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1-21 1-22 AN ACT

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relating to suicide prevention training for educators in public 1-23 1-24 schools.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. This Act may be cited as the Jason Flatt Act in memory of Jonathan Childers.

SECTION 2. Section 21.451, Education Code, is amended by amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsections (d-1) and (d-2) to read as follows:

- The staff development: (d)
 - may include training in: (1)
 - (A) technology;
 - (B) conflict resolution;
- (C) discipline strategies, including classroom management, district discipline policies, and the student code of conduct adopted under Section 37.001 and Chapter 37; and

(D) preventing, identifying, responding to, and

reporting incidents of bullying; [and]

- (2) subject to Subsection (e) and to Section 21.3541 and rules adopted under that section, must include training based on scientifically based research, as defined by Section 9101, No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 (20 U.S.C. Section 7801), that:
- (A) related to instruction of students with disabilities; and
- (B) is designed for educators who work primarily outside the area of special education; and
- 1-47 1-48 (3) must include suicide prevention training that must be 1-49 provided:
- <u>(A</u>) 1-50 on an annual basis, as part of a new employee orientation, to all new school district and open-enrollment charter school educators; and 1-51 1-52
- 1-53 to existing school district and open-enrollment (B) 1-54 charter school educators on a schedule adopted by the agency by 1-55 rule.
- 1-56 (d-1)The suicide prevention training required bу (d)(3) must use a best practice-based program 1-57 Subsection recommended by the Department of State Health Services 1-58 in 1-59 coordination with the agency under Section 161.325, Health and 1-60 Safety Code.
