1-17 relating to certain emergency services districts that are exempted
1-18 from filing an audit report.

1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Section [775.0821](#), Health and Safety Code, is
1-21 amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (e) to
1-22 read as follows:

1-23 (a) This section applies only to a district to which Section
1-24 [775.082](#) applies that:

1-25 (1) did not have any outstanding bonds secured by ad
1-26 valorem taxes or any outstanding liabilities secured by ad valorem
1-27 taxes having a term of more than one year during the previous fiscal
1-28 year;

1-29 (2) did not receive more than a total of \$250,000 in
1-30 gross receipts from operations, loans, taxes, or contributions
1-31 during the previous fiscal year; and

1-32 (3) did not have a total of more than \$250,000 in cash
1-33 and temporary investments during the previous fiscal year.

1-34 (e) A district that files compiled financial statements in
1-35 accordance with Subsection (b) and that maintains an Internet
1-36 website shall have posted on the district's website the compiled
1-37 financial statements for the most recent three years.

1-38 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.

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
