1-18 relating to designating January as Human Trafficking Prevention
 1-19 Month.

1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-21 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 662, Government Code, is
 1-22 amended by adding Section 662.107 to read as follows:

1-23 Sec. 662.107. HUMAN TRAFFICKING PREVENTION MONTH.

1-24 (a) January is Human Trafficking Prevention Month to increase
 1-25 awareness of human trafficking in an effort to encourage people to
 1-26 alert authorities to any suspected incidents involving human
 1-27 trafficking.

1-28 (b) Human Trafficking Prevention Month may be regularly
 1-29 observed through appropriate activities in public schools and other
 1-30 places to increase awareness and prevention of human trafficking.

1-31 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
