1-19 relating to the relationship between the Estates Code and the
 1-20 former Texas Probate Code.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. (a) This section takes effect only if the Act of
 1-23 the 84th Legislature, Regular Session, 2015, relating to
 1-24 nonsubstantive additions to and corrections in enacted codes
 1-25 becomes law.

1-26 (b) Section 21.002, Estates Code, is amended to read as
 1-27 follows:

1-28 Sec. 21.002. CONSTRUCTION. (a) Except as provided by [~~this~~
 1-29 ~~section,~~] Section 22.027[~~7~~] or [~~Section~~] 1002.023, Chapter 311,
 1-30 Government Code (Code Construction Act), applies to the
 1-31 construction of a provision of this code.

1-32 (b) This code and the Texas Probate Code, as amended, shall
 1-33 be considered one continuous statute, and for the purposes of any
 1-34 instrument that refers to the Texas Probate Code, this code shall be
 1-35 considered an amendment to the Texas Probate Code [Chapter 311,
 1-36 Government Code (Code Construction Act), does not apply to the
 1-37 construction of a provision of Subtitle X, Title 2, or Subtitle Y or
 1-38 Z, Title 3].

1-39 SECTION 2. (a) This section takes effect only if the Act of
 1-40 the 84th Legislature, Regular Session, 2015, relating to
 1-41 nonsubstantive additions to and corrections in enacted codes does
 1-42 not become law.

1-43 (b) Section 21.002, Estates Code, is amended by adding
 1-44 Subsection (c) to read as follows:

1-45 (c) This code and the Texas Probate Code, as amended, shall
 1-46 be considered one continuous statute, and for the purposes of any
 1-47 instrument that refers to the Texas Probate Code, this code shall be
 1-48 considered an amendment to the Texas Probate Code.

1-49 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-50 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-51 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-52 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-53 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
