1-18 relating to the ability of certain county assistance districts to
 1-19 annex roads.

1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-21 SECTION 1. Chapter 387, Local Government Code, is amended
 1-22 by adding Section 387.0031 to read as follows:

1-23 Sec. 387.0031. INCLUSION OF ROADS IN CERTAIN DISTRICTS.

1-24 (a) This section applies only to a district created by a county with
 1-25 a population of more than 580,000 that borders a county with a
 1-26 population of more than four million.

1-27 (b) The governing body of a district by order may include in
 1-28 the district a portion of a road, including associated drainage
 1-29 areas, that is located in a municipality located in the county that
 1-30 created the district if the municipality consents to the inclusion.
 1-31 An election is not required to approve an order described by this
 1-32 subsection.

1-33 (c) The district may use money available to the district to
 1-34 perform maintenance or improvement on a road and the associated
 1-35 drainage areas included in the district in accordance with this
 1-36 section.

1-37 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-38 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-39 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-40 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-41 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
