A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

relating to requiring the Department of Family and Protective 1-19 Services to study the effectiveness of the relative and other 1-20 1-21 designated caregiver placement program. 1-22

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1**-**23 SECTION 1. Subchapter I, Chapter 264, Family Code, amended by adding Section 264.761 to read as follows: is 1-24

Sec. 264.761. STUDY OF PROGRAM. (a) The department shall 1-25 study the effectiveness of the relative and other designated caregiver placement program created by this subchapter and make recommendations to the legislature for improving the program. The 1-26 1-27 1-28 1-29 recommended improvements must be designed to minimize the number of placements for each child, maximize efficiency in the distribution 1-30 of any monetary or other assistance for which caregivers qualify, facilitate a safe and permanent exit from the managing conservatorship of the department in as timely a fashion as 1-31 1-32 1-33 possible, and assist caregivers in obtaining the verification 1-34 1-35 necessary to qualify for foster care maintenance reimbursement. The recommendations may include increases in the amount of assistance and the identification of automated or other processes designed to speed the payment of assistance. 1-36 1-37 1-38 1-39

(b) The department shall report findings its and 1-40 recommendations to the legislature not later than January 1, 2017. (c) This section expires September 1, 2017. 1-41 1-42

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.

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
