1-19 relating to the use of a concealed handgun license as valid proof of  
 1-20 personal identification.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Subtitle A, Title 11, Business & Commerce Code,  
 1-23 is amended by adding Chapter 506 to read as follows:

1-24 CHAPTER 506. CONCEALED HANDGUN LICENSES AS VALID FORMS OF  
 1-25 PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION

1-26 Sec. 506.001. CONCEALED HANDGUN LICENSE AS VALID PROOF OF  
 1-27 IDENTIFICATION. (a) A person may not deny the holder of a  
 1-28 concealed handgun license issued under Subchapter H, Chapter 411,  
 1-29 Government Code, access to goods, services, or facilities, except  
 1-30 as provided by Section 521.460, Transportation Code, or in regard  
 1-31 to the operation of a motor vehicle, because the holder has or  
 1-32 presents a concealed handgun license rather than a driver's license  
 1-33 or other acceptable form of personal identification.

1-34 (b) This section does not affect:

1-35 (1) the requirement under Section 411.205, Government  
 1-36 Code, that a person subject to that section present a driver's  
 1-37 license or identification certificate in addition to a concealed  
 1-38 handgun license; or

1-39 (2) the types of identification required under federal  
 1-40 law to access airport premises or pass through airport security.

1-41 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
