A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1-19 relating to the qualifications for a coronal polishing certificate. 1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 1-21

SECTION 1. Section 265.006(b), Occupations Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-22 1-23 (b) To qualify for a coronal polishing certificate, an applicant must have at least two years' experience as a dental 1-24 1-25 assistant and:

1-26 (1) have successfully completed at least eight hours of clinical and didactic education in coronal polishing taken through a <u>dental school</u>, <u>dental hygiene school</u>, <u>or</u> <u>dental assisting</u> program accredited by the Commission on Dental Accreditation of the 1-27 1-28 1-29 1-30 American Dental Association and approved by the board. The 1-31 education must include [that includes] courses on:

1-32 (A) oral anatomy and tooth morphology relating to 1-33 retention of plaque and stain;

1-34 (B) indications, contraindications, and 1-35 complications of coronal polishing;

1-36 (C) principles of coronal polishing, including 1-37 armamentarium, operator and patient positioning, technique, and 1-38 polishing agents; 1-39

(D) infection control procedures;

polishing coronal surfaces of teeth; and (E)

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or

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(F) jurisprudence relating to coronal polishing;

present proof to the board that the assistant has: (2)

(A) graduated from a dental assisting program 1 - 441-45 accredited by the Commission on Dental Accreditation of the American Dental Association and approved by the board that includes 1-46 1-47 specific didactic course work and clinical training in coronal 1-48 polishing; or

1-49 (B) received certification of completion of 1-50 requirements specified by the Dental Assisting National Board and approved by the board. 1-51

1-52 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date 1-53 of this Act, the State Board of Dental Examiners shall adopt rules 1-54 necessary to implement Section 265.006(b), Occupations Code, as 1-55 amended by this Act. SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.

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
