1-15 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to the amount that may be donated by contract by certain
 1-18 populous counties to crime stoppers or crime prevention
 1-19 organizations.

1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-21 SECTION 1. Section 351.901(b), Local Government Code, is
 1-22 amended to read as follows:

1-23 (b) The commissioners court of a county by contract may
 1-24 donate money to one or more crime stoppers or crime prevention
 1-25 organizations for expenditure by the organizations to meet the
 1-26 goals identified in Subsection (a). The total amount of all
 1-27 donations made in a calendar year may not exceed:

1-28 (1) \$25,000; or
 1-29 (2) \$100,000, for a county with a population of one
 1-30 million or more.

1-31 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-32 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-33 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-34 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-35 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
