 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the standards for boiler inspection agencies.
 1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
 1-21 SECTION 1. Section 755.032(a), Health and Safety Code, is
 1-22 amended to read as follows:
 1-23 (a) The commission may adopt and enforce rules, in
 1-24 accordance with standard boiler usage, for the construction,
 1-25 inspection, installation, use, maintenance, repair, alteration,
 1-26 and operation of boilers. The commission may adopt standards for an
 1-27 inspection agency to be authorized by the department to provide
 1-28 inspections under this chapter.
 1-29 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-30 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-31 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-32 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-33 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
