1-17 relating to training requirements for peace officers appointed to
 1-18 supervisory positions.

1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Section 1701.352(d), Occupations Code, is
 1-21 amended to read as follows:

1-22 (d) A peace officer who is appointed or will be appointed to
 1-23 the officer's first supervisory position must receive in-service
 1-24 training on supervision as part of the course provided for the
 1-25 officer under Subsection (b) not earlier than the 12th month before
 1-26 the date of that appointment or later than the first anniversary of
 1-27 ~~[during the 24-month period after]~~ the date of that appointment.

1-28 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
 1-29 to an appointment made on or after the effective date of this Act.
 1-30 An appointment made before the effective date of this Act is
 1-31 governed by the law in effect on the date the appointment was made,
 1-32 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

1-33 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
