BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-21 SECTION 1. Sections 11.48(a) and (b), Tax Code, are amended to read as follows:

1-22 1-23 (a) A driver's license number, personal identification certificate number, or social security account number provided in 1-24 an application for an exemption filed with a chief appraiser is 1-25 confidential and not open to public inspection. The information may not be disclosed to anyone other than an employee <u>or agent</u> of the appraisal <u>district</u> [<del>office</del>] who appraises property <u>or performs</u> <u>appraisal services for the appraisal district</u>, except as authorized 1-26 1-27 1-28 1-29 1-30 by Subsection (b).

(b) Information made confidential by this section may be 1-31 1-32 disclosed:

1-33 in a judicial or administrative proceeding (1)1-34 pursuant to a lawful subpoena;

1-35 (2) to the person who filed the application or to the 1-36 person's representative authorized in writing to receive the 1-37 information;

1-38 (3) to the comptroller and the comptroller's employees 1-39 authorized by the comptroller in writing to receive the information or to an assessor or a chief appraiser if requested in writing; 1-40
