A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-21 SECTION 1. Section 2157.007, Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-22 1-23 Sec. 2157.007. CONSIDERATION [ADVANCED OF CLOUD 1-24 **INTERNET-BASED**] COMPUTING SERVICE PURCHASE. (a) "Cloud [Advanced Internet-based] computing service" has the meaning assigned by 1-25 Special Publication 800-145 issued by the United States Department of Commerce National Institute of Standards and Technology, as the definition existed on January 1, 2015 [means a service that 1-26 1-27 1-28 provides network access to a shared pool of configurable computing 1-29 including networks, servers, resources on demand, 1-30 1-31 applications, or related technology services, that may be rapidly provisioned and released by the service provider with minimal 1-32 effort and interaction. The term 1 - 33does not include or the act 1-34 telecommunications <u>service</u> of hosting -computing resources dedicated to a single purchaser]. 1-35

(b) A state agency may consider <u>cloud</u> [advanced Internet-based] computing service options, including any cost associated with purchasing those service options, when making 1-36 1-37 1-38 1-39 purchases for a major information resources project under Section 1-40 2054.118.

A state agency shall ensure that information resources 1-41 (c) 1-42 projects that use <u>cloud</u> [advanced Internet-based] computing service options meet or exceed required state standards for 1-43 1 - 44cybersecurity.

1-45 (d) Using existing resources, the department may review the process for the coordinated development, hosting, and management of computer software for state agencies that use <u>cloud</u> [advanced Internet-based] computing services. 1-46 1-47 1-48 1-49
